Well, it's been a little more than a year since we launched our 50th Anniversary Reunion activities. And we're off to a great start! Contributions to our Class Gift are progressing just fine, and our major social event last year . . . Family Day 2008 . . . was a resounding success.

Our Social Committee and Mainland Coordination Team have put together a tremendous program for our 2009 reunion in Las Vegas, and I have enclosed a copy of the week's agenda along with a summary of the scheduled major events. Please note that you will have to make your own travel and hotel arrangements. If you plan on using a vacation package, such as Vacations Hawaii, air travel and a hotel room are usually a part of the package. However, if you require a hotel room only, we have reserved a block of rooms at the California Hotel for the period September 21 – 25, 2009. The rate per person for a double occupancy room is \$130 for a 2 night package, \$150 for a 3 night package and \$165 for a 4 night package. For a single occupant, the rates are \$195, \$225 and \$248, respectively. The packages include meal coupons for breakfast, lunch and dinner for the # of days booked, and the coupons can be used in any of the downtown Boyd hotels. The room reservation must be made by August 1, 2009 and a \$50 deposit will be required at the time of booking. For reservations, call the California Hotel's Room Reservation Department at (800) 634-6255 and give them Group Code: A9FST62.

There are many other activities that can be scheduled on an individual basis during our stay in Las Vegas.
